### Economical:

- Provides alternatives to gas prices
- Helps to create and maintain jobs, as well as takes people to and from their jobs
- Provides a greater return on investment than traditionally funded transportation projects (e.g. roadway construction and maintenance)

### Environmental:

- Reduces greenhouse emissions
- Conserves energy and natural resources
- Reduces noise, water, and light pollution

- Reduces U.S. dependence on foreign oil
- Connects workers to jobs in suburban and rural areas

### Statistics

According to the American Public Transportation Association's "Transit Saving Report", one person can achieve an annual average savings of over \$8000 by taking public transit.

Each year, public transportation use in the U.S. saves the equivalent of 300,000 fewer automobile fill-ups each day.
